



Report on the Effect on Electric Ratepayer Classes of Ordinance No. 20231005-033



On November 22, 2023, pursuant to authority granted by Ordinance No. 20230816-007, as later amended in 20231005-033, Austin Energy administratively implemented a five percent increase in the power supply adjustment, effective for all utility bills rendered on or after December 1, 2023. As required by Texas Utilities Code § 33.103, this report states the effect of the ordinance on each class of ratepayer.
